Here is some additional information about the Picard Series: *Star Trek: Picard* is an upcoming American web television series created for CBS All Access by executive producer Alex Kurtzman. It will be the eighth series in the *Star Trek* franchise and centers on the character Jean-Luc Picard. Set at the end of the 24th century, 20 years after the events of *Star Trek: Nemesis* (2002), the storyline is affected by the destruction of the planet Romulus referenced in the film *Star Trek* (2009), as well as the death of Data in *Nemesis*.

Patrick Stewart executive produces the series and stars as Picard, reprising his role from *Star Trek: The Next Generation* as well as other *Star Trek* media. Santiago Cabrera, Michelle Hurd, Evan Evagora, Alison Pill, Harry Treadaway, and Isa Briones also star. Several actors from previous *Star Trek* series will also reprise their roles, including Brent Spiner, Jeri Ryan, Marina Sirtis, and Jonathan Frakes.^[1] The series was first rumored in June 2018 when Kurtzman began his expansion, and was officially announced that August after months of negotiations with Stewart, who had previously said he would not return to the franchise after *Nemesis*. Filming began in California in April 2019, with the series' official title announced a month later.

Star Trek: Picard is scheduled to premiere on January 23, 2020, and its first season will consist of ten episodes. Ahead of the premiere, CBS All Access renewed *Star Trek: Picard* for a 10-episode second season! (That is virtually unheard of). We are in active discussions about having a possible Picard and/or Discovery Watch Party...more to come on that!

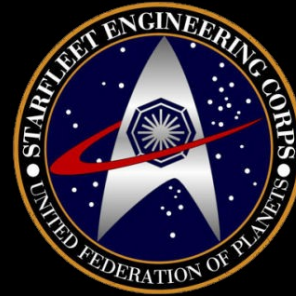

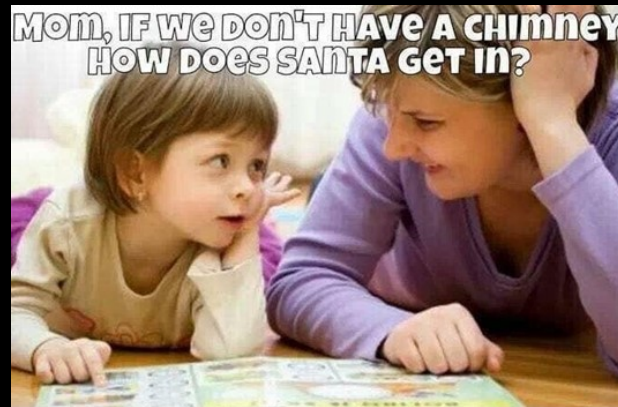

I wanted to imagine what Jackson can and will be. Before something can happen in reality, though, we must be able to visualize it, to conceptualize it happening, and finally, to WORK at it. LEGO Jackson is just one vision of our Capital City, as a clean, safe, pedestrian friendly community that welcomes everyone. It has well-kept houses, bike lanes, sustainable energy sources, accessible streets and sidewalks, public transit, and most important of all, civic pride. People in LEGO Jackson don't litter, but pick up trash. They get to know their neighbors, confront crime and injustice, care about each other, and respect themselves and their city.

Building with LEGO is a lot like living a life with multiple sclerosis: creating something meaningful using fewer bricks than you once had. It requires creativity and a willingness to rebuild something new out of what you have left.

Eventually she passed, and acquired the Starfleet status of a line officer, on top of being considered a staff officer and still ship's counselor.
